

To Airline Operators at Copenhagen Airport - to whom it may concern!

The budget for ACD – Airport Coordination Denmark A/S – has been approved and the final charges for 2022 will be as follows:

DKK 10,50 per turn-around for runway constraints.
DKK 3,80 additional charge per turn-around for CPH Go.
I.e. Total charge DKK 14,30 per turn-around for CPH Go.

Unfortunately, the huge drop in air traffic is still reflected. We hope that traffic over 2022 can reach between 60 and 65 percent of 2019 traffic, which we have used as a basis for the expected revenue in 2022.

We continue to keep costs down, continue with the reduced office space, postpone renewals and downsize the travel activities.

Based on very low expenses in 2021 and the continued savings in 2022, however, we see the possibility of being able to reduce the price by DKK 0,50 ~ almost 5 percent!

It is not much, but still a step in the right direction.

Naturally, we hope that traffic will soon be normalized so that prices can be reduced again in 2023.

The slot charge will apply to Copenhagen Airport and the charge will as previously be invoiced on behalf of ACD by Copenhagen Airport A/S as a specific charge per departure in addition to the airport charges.

On top of the amount collected from the operators – Copenhagen Airport A/S will continue; as they have done since 1996 – to finance the other half of the costs.

ACD is a nonprofit company, and we will always be working with estimates of operations for the next 12 months, so please be aware of the fact – that the charges could either increase or decrease over the year.
